

Series 9500 Marine Intercom System Radio Adapter Cord OPERATION SHEET

The Radio Adapter Cords are used to interface a U9510BS (40795G-03) Belt Station to a hand-held portable radio.

Installation




Figure 1: U9510BS Belt Station Connections

- 1. Disconnect the C95-12BS Belt Station Straight Cable or the C95-15BS Belt Station Coil Cord from the U9510BS Belt Station. This connector is color-coded red for identification (see Fig. 1).
 - a. To disconnect cable, turn collar ¼ turn clockwise and pull.
 - b. The U9510BS Belt Station must be disconnected from the intercom or the transmissions will not go over the hand-held radio, but over the radio selected at the Master Station.
- 2. Connect the Radio Adapter cord to the U9510BS Belt Station by aligning the two yellow color-coded lines and pushing together.
- Connect the radio end of the Radio Adapter Cord to the hand-held radio's accessory connector. Be sure radio's power is OFF. This procedure will vary for different types of radios.

Operation

- 1. Once connected, turn on the power to the hand-held radio.
- 2. If not already connected, connect a H9530 or H9540 headset to the top connector on the U9510BS Belt Station using the same procedure as the Radio Adapter Cord above. The headset connector is color-coded green.
- 3. The headset-microphone is now interfaced to the hand-held radio.
 - a. To transmit, press the PTT.
 - b. The position of the Radio/Intercom Select Switch must be in RAD if VOX operation is desired (must be supported by radio)
- 4. Remember, the U9510BS must not be connected to the Intercom System. If it is, you will not be transmitting over the hand-held, but over the radio selected at the Master Station.
